Alice Beryl Conner, 59, of Jasper View Lane, Millsboro, Delaware, and formerly of Orangeville, died suddenly on Monday, August 12, 2013 at the Beebe Medical Center Emergency Room in Lewes, Delaware. She had been a resident of Millsboro, Delaware since 2000.

Born April 27, 1954 at the Bloomsburg Hospital, she was a daughter of Mary Lou (George) Conner of Orangeville and the late Haurice J. Conner.
