Arnold Clinton Kinney, 83, of Asbury Road, Orangeville, died early Tuesday morning, October 16, 2012 at the Orangeville Nursing and Rehabilitation Center where he had been a resident since January 2011.

Born September 2, 1929 in Greenwood Township, he was a son of the late James Kinney and Belma Bardo. He and his wife, Naomi I. (Roberts) Kinney, celebrated their 59th wedding anniversary on June 27th.

Mr. Kinney was a 1947 graduate of Millville High School. He proudly served his country in the U. S. Army from 1948 to 1951, attaining the rank of Sergeant.
