Doris M. Evans, 84, of Benton, died Monday, April 30, 2012 at the Orangeville Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Born September 13, 1927 in Muncy, Lycoming County, she was a daughter of the late Raymond G. Evans, Sr. and Amanda (Hunsinger) Evans.

She attended schools in Muncy and Greenwood.
