



Doris R. (Robbins) Spiece

September 29, 1942 - July 14, 2015

Doris R. (Robbins) Spiece, 72, of Sones Hollow Road, Benton, died early Tuesday morning, July 14th, at her home. She had been ill for the past 10 weeks.

Born September 29, 1942 in Bloomsburg, she was a daughter of the late Leon A. Robbins who died September 19, 2013 and Leona G. (Sones) Robbins, who died October 23, 1983. She and her husband, Luther C. Spiece, would have celebrated their 52nd wedding anniversary on December 14th.

Mrs. Spiece was a 1960 graduate of Benton High School. She had cooked at various area restaurants for many years and later worked as secretary/treasurer for both Jackson Township and Greenwood Township. She retired in 2008 from Greenwood Township.

She was a member of the Waller United Methodist Church. Active in the community, she was a lifetime member of the Benton Volunteer Fire Company and the Benton Ambulance where she was an EMT and had served as secretary.

In her youth she was active with 4-H. She enjoyed being a homemaker and was well known for her cooking, baking and tending to her flowers. She also enjoyed camping and traveling.

Surviving, in addition to her husband, Luther, are her son, Carl L. Spiece and his wife, Ann, of Benton; a grandson, Logan C. Spiece, and his fiancée, Katrina Hess, of Benton; her siblings: Betty J. Edwards and her husband, Allen, of Berwick; Pat R. Sterner and her husband, Jim, of Waller; Ronnie K. Robbins and his wife, Charity, of Waller; Richard W. Robbins and his wife, Linda, of Berwick as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Along with her parents, she was preceded in death by her beloved granddaughter, Stephanie Ann Spiece, on June 21, 2009.
