Edith R. (Troy) Robbins, 91, formerly of Bissett Lane, Bloomsburg died early Tuesday morning, July 2, 2013 at Manor Care in Jersey Shore, where she had been a resident for the past nine and a half years.

Born August 2, 1921 in Fernville, she was a daughter of the late Harry and Mary (English) Troy. She was preceded in death by her husband, Ted E. Robbins, on May 9, 2001.

A 1939 graduate of Bloomsburg High School, Mrs. Robbins had worked for the former Letterman Bakery in Bloomsburg in the 1950's; the former Racasin Clothing Store in Berwick and Bloomsburg; Brown's Catering Service of Danville and also for the Bloomsburg University cafeteria.

Mrs. Robbins also assisted her husband with the operation of a grocery store while living in Espy for many years.

She had been an active member of the Ridge Street United Methodist Church where she was involved in the kitchen and was in charge of the pies and deserts for the church suppers. She was a member of the United Methodist Women, was a trustee and served on the Administrative board of the church.

More recently she had been attending the Nippenose Bible Fellowship Church.

She enjoyed being a homemaker and was known for her baking. She loved to share with her neighbors and friends, especially her cinnamon flop cake.

Surviving are her daughter, Mary Helen Winter and her husband Frank, of 1523 Stopper Road, Williamsport, PA 17702; 2 grandchildren: Matthew Winter and Theresa Ondrejik and a great grandson, Kyle Ondrejik.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by 2 brothers: Harold and Donald Troy and a sister, Alma Taylor.
