



## Elwin F. Mulaney

December 16, 1920 - March 30, 2010

Elwin F. Mulaney, 89, of Hemlock Hollow Road, Benton, Pine Township, died early Tuesday morning, March 30th, 2010 at Geisinger Medical Center, Danville.

Born December 16, 1920 in Clinton Township, Wayne County, he was a son of the late Francis J. and Madeline (Terrel) Mulaney. He was preceded in death by his wife, Helen F. (Hess) Mulaney on May 3rd, 2000.

Mr. Mulaney owned and operated a farm in Talmar for 48 years and had also worked at the former GLF in Bloomsburg for a few years.

He was a member of the Baptist Church in Clinton Township, Wayne County and more recently attended the Christian Gospel Fellowship Church of Iola.

He attended Mount Pleasant High School and Aldenville High School in Wayne County. He served his country during World War II as a Staff Sergeant in the U. S. Army and had been awarded the American Defense Service Medal with a Star; the American Service Medal; the Asiatic-Pacific Service Medal; the European-African-Middle Eastern Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

Mr. Mulaney had served on the Millville Area School Board for many years.

Surviving, are his 3 children: Joyce E. Meek and her husband, Eugene, of Jerseytown; Sandra M. Smith of Millville; Kenneth R. Mulaney and his wife, Janet, of Talmar; 8 grandchildren; 10 great grandchildren; a brother, Hubert W. Mulaney and his wife, Hilda, of Stillwater.

In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by the following siblings: Leon C. Mulaney in 2009; Alta Shepherd in 1998; Kenneth Mulaney in 1931; Robert Mulaney in 1933; Edward G. Mulaney in 1948 and a brother that died in infancy in 1932.

Funeral Services will be held Monday, April 5th at 10:30 A. M. at the McMichael Funeral Home, Inc., 4394 Red Rock Road, Benton (Rt. 487) with Pastor Paul Converse, Sr., officiating.
