



Eugene F. "Gene" Kinney

January 30, 1936 - February 2, 2014

Eugene F. "Gene" Kinney, 78, of Bardo Road, Millville, and formerly of Raven Creek, died Sunday morning, February 2, 2014 at his home. He had been in declining health for the past 10 years.

Born January 30, 1936 in Greenwood Township, he was a son of the late Belma V. Bardo. He was raised on the family farm by his mother, Belma, and his grandparents, Ellis and Jeannie Bardo. He and his wife, Helen J. (Pursley) Kinney, would have celebrated their 53rd wedding anniversary on June 24th.

Mr. Kinney worked as an operating engineer employed by Bill Anskis, Inc., of Elysburg and was a member of Union Local 542. He also drove truck for various companies including Wise Potato Chip Co., Wayne "Sharky" Young, and Delvin Whitenight. He also farmed and loved to tinker in his woodshed. 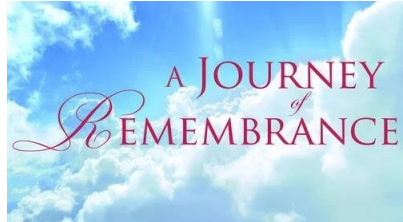
