



George R. "Kelly" Kellner

George R. "Kelly" Kellner, of Rakich Road, Benton and formerly of Lansdale, died early Sunday morning, January 20th, 2013 at the home of his son and daughter-in-law, Robert Lee and Darlene Kellner.

Born September 17, 1918 in Hazleton, he was a son of the late George and Nora (McHugh) Kellner. He was preceded in death by his wife, Gladys M. (Sterling) Kellner on October 30, 2006.

He was a graduate of Hazleton High School. He proudly and faithfully served his country in the U. S. Army in World War II. He had been awarded the Combat Infantry Badge, the European African Middle Eastern Campaign Medal, the Good Conduct Medal and the World War II Victory Medal.

Mr. Kellner was a machinist by trade and had been employed for many years by the S. K. F. Company in Philadelphia in the Aircraft Division.

Mr. Kellner was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church of Benton and while living in Lansdale was a member of St. Stanislaus Catholic Church.

His hobbies included hunting, fishing and reading. He also enjoyed watching old westerns on TV and spending time with his grandchildren and family.

Surviving are his 2 sons: Joseph Donald Kellner, of Lansdale; Robert Lee Kellner and his wife, Darlene, with whom he made his home in Benton; 5 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren.

In addition to his wife and parents, he was preceded in death by 4 siblings.
