George B. Morris, formerly of Stillwater, died Sunday, February 1, 2015 at Geisinger Bloomsburg Hospital.

Born October 24, 1923 in Danville, he was a son of the late David A. and Clara E. (Springer) Morris. He was preceded in death by his wife, Marion E. (Faust) Morris on March 11, 1999.

Mr. Morris faithfully served our country in the U. S. Army in during World War II. He served in Co. C 628th Tank Des. Battalion. He had been awarded the American Theatre Service Medal, the European African Middle Eastern Service Medal with 3 bronze stars, the World War II Victory Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

He was a past commander for the Millville American Legion and a 12 term past commander for the Benton V. F. W. He was also a councilman for Stillwater Borough for 19 years and a social member of the Slavonic Club in Berwick.

He was employed as a stainless steel polisher at Girton Manufacturing in Millville, retiring in 1985.

Along with his wife, he was preceded in death by 2 step children: Carol Posey and Dan Reabuck; 3 brothers: Ralph, David and Benjamin "Walter" Morris and by 3 sisters: Mary Morris, in infancy; Clara Baylor and Edna.
