



## Gerald D. Stevens

January 3, 1933 - July 9, 2010

Gerald D. Stevens, 77, of Benton, died Friday afternoon, July 9th, 2010 at Geisinger Medical Center, Danville, where he had been a patient for the past 11 days.

Born January 3, 1933 in Benton Township, he was a son of the late Paul S. Stevens who died May 6, 1997 and Madeline C. (Karns) Stevens, who died March 1, 2010.
