



Lawrence B. Shaw

July 11, 1936 - July 28, 2014

Lawrence B. Shaw, 78, of Boyek Road, Shickshinny, died Monday evening, July 28, 2014 at the Bonham Nursing and Rehabilitation Center where he had been a resident for only a week

Born July 11, 1936 in rural Shickshinny, he was a son of the late Lawrence Halbert and Alberta Louise (Hartman) Shaw. He and his wife, Carol Ann (Miller) Shaw, would have celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary this August 6th.

He attended Sugarloaf and Derrs Schools and was a graduate of Benton High School in 1955. Lawrence was self-employed as a truck driver and mechanic for many years and also worked at the Benton Roller Mills and the Andreas Greenhouses in Nescopeck. Lawrence was a member of the Stillwater Christian Church where he served as Deacon and the Sunday School Superintendent. He was also a member of the National Rifle Association and loved spending his time hunting throughout the area.

Surviving in addition to his wife, are four siblings: Sarah Seeley of Greenville, PA; Glenn Shaw and wife, Betty Jean, of Orangeville; Beverly Edwards and husband, Keith, of New Columbus; and Lloyd Shaw and wife, Jackie, of Springville, PA

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother: Thomas Shaw in 2002.
