



## Mahlon Thomas Hartman

July 9, 1931 - January 11, 2014

Mahlon Thomas Hartman, 82, of Cambra, died Saturday, January 11th, 2014 at Grandview Health Homes, Inc., Danville, where he had been a resident since April 2012.

Born July 9, 1931 in Benton, he was a son of the late Loys T. and Ethel E. (Davis) Hartman. He was preceded in death by his two wives: Pauline Elizabeth (Knouse) Hartman on February 12, 1988 and Marjorie (Hess) Steiner Hartman on June 18, 2002.
