August 16, 1980 - January 29, 2015

Michael E. "Mike" Moskovich, 34, of Bloomsburg, died Thursday, January 29, 2015 from injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident. He is now in the presence of his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

He was born August 16, 1980 in Bloomsburg. He was a son of Emil Moskovich and Shirley (Geisler) Moskovich, of Bloomsburg. He and his wife, Julie L. (Ammerman) Moskovich, would have celebrated their 8th wedding anniversary on July 7th.

He was a 1999 graduate of Bloomsburg High School and a 2001 graduate of the Pennsylvania College of Technology. Mike was employed as a mechanic at the Susquehanna Nuclear Power Plant near Berwick for the past 7 years. Prior to that he owned and operated Heartwood Construction in Bloomsburg.

Mike was saved by the grace of God and loved others with the love Christ showed him. He was an active member of the Stillwater Christian Church, where he was a part of the Men's Fraternity Class. He loved his family dearly and enjoyed spending time with them. He was grateful for the blessing that his wife and family were to him. He and his family loved being outdoors together.

Surviving, in addition to his wife and parents, are his four children: Travis and Tyler Pequignot; Luke and Ava Moskovich; a brother, Mark Moskovich and his

wife, Rachel, of Louisville, Kentucky; grandparents: Emil and Margaret Moskovich of West Hazleton and Elwood and Blanche Geisler, of Boynton Beach, Florida.

A Visitation will be held Tuesday from 3 to 6 PM at the Stillwater Christian Church, 42 Wesley Street, Stillwater. The Funeral Service will begin at 6:30 PM at the Church with Pastor Jeff Farley, officiating. Burial will be private at New Rosemont Cemetery, Espy.
