



Nancy L. (Young) Laubach

May 12, 1946 - February 15, 2014

Nancy L. (Young) Laubach, 67, of Benton, died late Saturday evening, February 15, 2014 at Geisinger Medical Center, Danville where she had been a patient for the past week.

Born May 12, 1946 in Bloomsburg, she was a daughter of the late Owen H. "Tony" Young who died March 27, 1970 and Ethel Anna (Hess) Young who died March 12, 1948. She and her husband, Kenneth C. Laubach would have celebrated their 49th wedding anniversary on August 21st.

Mrs. Laubach was a 1964 graduate of Benton High School and also graduated from the Ja'Mel School of Cosmetology in 1973. She operated a beauty salon in Benton for 15 years. She served on the Benton Borough Council.

She loved bus trips to anywhere and as often as possible. Her love to travel took her to places that included Hawaii, Kentucky, Cancun, Jamaica and the Dominican Republic.

Mrs. Laubach loved to bake, especially apple dumplings and sugar cookies. Her rice pudding could not be beat....all while watching QVC.

Laubach and his wife, Pam, of Orangeville; Jeffrey Laubach and his wife, Hope, of Central; 2 grandsons: Mason and Chad Laubach; a sister, Phyllis Harrison, a resident of Orangeville Nursing and Rehab. Center, and numerous nieces and nephews.

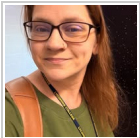
