



Robert G. "Bob" Wenner

Robert G. "Bob" Wenner, 74, of 144 Bendertown Road, Orangeville, died early Tuesday morning, September 9, 2014 at his home. He had been in declining health for the past two years.

Born March 20, 1940 in Bloomsburg, he was a son of the late Fred and Ida (Polk) Wenner. He and his wife, Frances I. (Turner) Wenner, celebrated their 53rd wedding anniversary on June 10th.

Mr. Wenner attended Benton Schools and had lived in the Bendertown area all of his life. He was employed by the Orangeville Manufacturing Co. for several years and then went to work for AC&F Industries in Milton for 35 years where they manufactured railroad cars. He retired in May 2001.

He and his wife, Frances, were involved in cider making for several years. In his free time, he enjoyed his glider, four-wheeler and spending time with family and friends.

Mr. Wenner was a member of the Town Hill United Methodist Church and was a former member of the Benton Lions Club.
