



Robert C. "Bob" Williams

September 3, 1922 - February 7, 2011

Robert C. "Bob" Williams, 88, of Bloomsburg, died Monday afternoon, February 7th, 2011 at the Berwick Hospital Center where he had been a patient since Friday. He had been a resident of the Bloomsburg Health Care Center before entering the hospital.

Born September 3, 1922 in Plymouth, Luzerne County, he was a son of the late Clarence and Sadie (Jones) Williams. He and his wife, Anna K. (Kelly) Williams, would have celebrated their 63rd wedding anniversary on June 4th.

Mr. Williams had been employed as an Auxiliary Policeman for the Connecticut State Police while living in Connecticut and had also worked for the William B. Meyers Warehouse as a foreman. He later worked for Foam Fabricators.

Mr. Williams proudly served his country in World War II for four years in the U. S. Coast Guard.

He was a member of the First English Baptist Church of Bloomsburg and the Bloomsburg American Legion.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, Anna, are his 5 children: Sharon Moyer and her husband, Steven, of Wapwallopen; Deborah Damon and her husband,

David, of St. Augustine, Florida; Robert K. Williams and his wife, Terri, of Beaver, PA; Terry G. Williams and his wife, Julie, of Hyattsville, MD; Glen K. Williams and his wife, Yolanda, of El Paso, Texas. Also surviving are 14 grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren and two sisters: Dorothy Jean Bonn of Mountaintop and Lucid Peatt, of Newark, Del.

He was preceded in death by a son, Kenneth R. Williams in 2004 and by two sisters: Ardyth Lauffer and Anna Douglas.

Funeral Services will be held Friday at 11 A. M. at the First English Baptist Church, 700 Millville Road, Bloomsburg, with his pastor, the Rev. Dr. Lee Barnhardt, officiating. A Viewing will be held Friday from 10 AM until the time of the service at the church. Burial will be in the Emmanuel United Church of Christ Cemetery.
