Ruth E. (Weitzel) Mott, 76, of Marsh Creek Road, Shickshinny, died early Tuesday morning, August 28th, 2012 under the care of the Columbia Montour Home Hospice at the Bonham Nursing Center where she had been a guest for the last several weeks.

Born in Ft. Collins, Colorado, on April 10, 1936, she was a daughter of the late Jacob and Natalie (Felker) Weitzel.
