Tyson K. Galgon, 35, of Fourth Street, Bloomsburg and formerly of Benton, died suddenly and unexpectedly Friday afternoon, February 21st, 2014 at Geisinger Medical Center, Danville.

Born February 6, 1979 in Allentown, he was a son of Anthony and Karen (Owens) Galgon, of Benton.

Tyson lived in Bethlehem until moving to Benton in 1986. He was a 1998 graduate of Benton High School and attended the Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, Ohio. He was well known as a gifted and talented artist.

He had been employed as a sales associate at Wal-Mart for the past 13 years and attended the Benton Assembly of God Church.

Tyson loved art and was also an avid reader.
