### WALTER G. TIFFANY

Walter G. Tiffany, 56, of West Lawn, Berks County, died early Wednesday, June 20, 2012 at the Kindred Transitional Care and Rehabilitation of Reading.

Born August 10, 1955 in Chester, PA, he was a son of the late George Elmer Tiffany and Sadie Ellen (Keeler) Tiffany.

Walt graduated from Bloomsburg High School and then attended Clarion University. He came back to Bloomsburg to finish his degree and graduated from Bloomsburg University. He later earned his M.B.A. from St. Joe's University.

Walt was a Certified Public Accountant and had last been employed as the Controller and Treasurer by Chiyoda America Inc. in Morgantown, PA. In previous years he had done extensive work with the Salvation Army's Reading branch as their Treasurer.

Surviving and missing him are his two sons: Michael and Daniel Tiffany, both of Reading as well as their mother Janine Tiffany; his siblings: Allen Hess and his wife, Dorothy, of Benton; Delphine Meyers, of Palm Coast, FL; Ronald Hess and his wife, Sandra, of Ridley Park; Geneva Houseweart of Benton;
