



## Wesley C. Swanson

April 14, 1926 - September 9, 2010

Wesley C. Swanson, 84, of Sult Road, Millville, died suddenly on Thursday, September 9th, 2010, at the Emergency Room of Geisinger Medical Center, Danville.

Born April 14, 1926 in Newark, New Jersey, he was a son of the late Wesley E. and Mary Anna (Haase) Swanson.

Mr. Swanson proudly served his country in the U. S. Navy during World War II and the Korean War. He was an active member of the Benton V.F.W. and a member of the combined veterans group that provides Military Funeral Honors.

He was a structural iron worker employed by Leake and Nelson of Bridgeport, CT for 30 years, retiring in 1987. He was also a member of the Iron Workers Union, Local 424.

Mr. Swanson, and his wife Bette, also owned and operated The Log Home Bed And Breakfast in Greenwood Township from 1990 to 2003.

His hobbies included reading, wood working, hunting, camping and spending time with his best buddy; his trusty golden retriever, Rusty.

Surviving are his wife, Elizabeth M. "Bette" (Noble) Swanson, whom he married on January 17, 1981; 2 daughters: Laurie A. DeFeo, Millville; Sandra Swanson and her companion, Randy McConville, Newton, Mass.; a granddaughter, Julie DeFeo and her fiancée, Duston McElwee. Also surviving are a step son, Arthur Brennan and his wife, Sally of Nova Scotia.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his first wife, Julia (Dembinsky) Swanson on August 15, 1977 and by a son, Larry Swanson on July 25, 1982.

Memorial Services will be held Tuesday, September 14th, 2010 at 2 PM at the McMichael Funeral Home, Inc., 4394 Red Rock Road, Benton (Rt. 487) with Michael L.
