



William B. "Bill" Victory

William B. "Bill" Victory, 90, of Fritz Hill Road, Benton, Sugarloaf Township, died early Friday morning, January 11th, 2013 at Orangeville Nursing and Rehabilitation Center where he had been a resident since Wednesday.

Born March 29, 1922 in Niagara Falls, New York, he was a son of the late John C. and Laura (MacDonald) Victory. He and his wife, Betty Jane (Fritz) Victory celebrated their 63rd wedding anniversary on this past June 11th.

Mr. Victory graduated from Niagara Falls High School and also took courses at Erie County Tech. School. He proudly served his country in the U. S. Army during World War II and had been awarded the World War II Victory Medal, the American Service Medal, the European African Middle Eastern Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

He had a long career with Union Carbide in Niagara Falls, New York. He started as a draftsman and worked his way up to the supervisor in the metals research division, retiring in 1983 after 42 years of service.

Mr. Victory was an active member of St. Gabriel's Episcopal Church in Sugarloaf Township where he served as Senior Warden for 17 years.

His hobbies included reading, model trains, gardening and wood working.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, Betty, are his 3 children: Brian W. Victory and his wife, Julie, of Stroudsburg; Brenda J. Donley and her husband, Rev. Bruce Donley, of Akron, NY; Barry R. Victory and his wife, Susan, of Sanford, Florida; 3 grandchildren; Zachary, Hannah and Mariah Donley; a great granddaughter, Sophia Donley; 3 step grandchildren: Kristin Abell-Galella, Heather and Matthew Abell; 3 step great grandchildren: Drew, Abigail and Thomas Galella.

Funeral Services will be held Tuesday, January 15, 2013 at 11:00 A. M. at St. Gabriel's Episcopal Church with Father Andrew France, officiating.
